Prayer in WP(MD).No.16163 of 2017 :

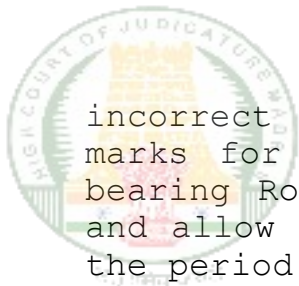
