PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.568 of 2019 on the file of the Respondent police

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 147, 148, 294(b), 341, 323, 324, 342, 307 and 506(ii) of I.P.C., in Crime No. 568 of 2019 on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

3. The learned Government Advocate states that the first petitioner was arrested and therefore this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed as far as the first petitioner is concerned.



4. The second petitioner is only said to have caught hold of the victim. He has no previous case. I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the second petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, second petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Melur, Madurai District, and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The second petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

5. The second petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
