O R D E R

Alleging non-compliance of the order dated 07.04.2016, made in W.P.(MD)No.6898 of 2016, the present contempt petition has been filed.

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2.Today, when the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned Standing Counsel appearing for the respondents submitted that the order of this Court, dated 07.04.2016, passed in W.P.(MD)No.6898 of 2016, has been complied with. However, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that all the amounts have been paid only with 6% interest and the cheques were not handed over to the petitioner on the date of the cheques and all the installments have been paid belatedly and therefore, the petitioner is entitled for 18% interest for the delayed period.

3.In reply, the learned Standing Counsel appearing for the respondents submitted that due to financial crisis, after obtaining lump sum amount from the Government, the entire amount was settled to the petitioner.

4.Recording the above said submissions, this contempt petition is closed. It is open to the petitioner to make a representation to the respondents for the remaining amount with interest, if any.

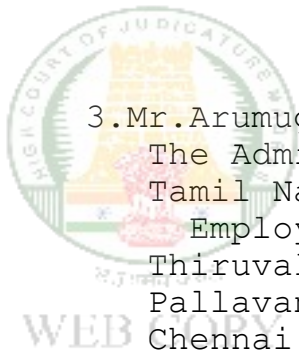
