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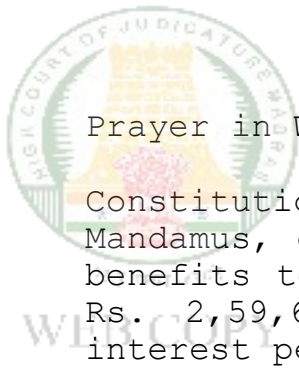

Common Prayer: Contempt Petition is filed under 11 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, to punish the contemnors/respondents herein for committing grave contempt and willful disobedience of the order passed by this Hon'ble Court in W.P(MD)No.15437 of 2016, dated 02.09.2016, WP(MD)No.17569 of 2016, dated 19.09.2016, WP(MD)No.17594 of 2016, dated 26.09.2016, WP(MD)No.17595 of 2016, dated 26.09.2016, and WP(MD)No.17384 of 2016, dated 06.10.2016 respectively.



Prayer in WP(MD). 15437/ 2016 :

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to pay the petitioners terminal benefits towards Gratuity amount Rs. 6,25,647/-, Commutation Amount Rs. 2,59,668/- and Leave Salary Rs. 1,23,275/- along with 18% interest per annum within a stipulated time frame as may be fixed by this Court.

Prayer in WP(MD). 17569/ 2016 :

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondent to pay the petitioner s terminal benefit towards gratuity Rs.5,70,000/- along with 18% interest per annum within a stipulated time frame as may be fixed by this Court.

Prayer in WP(MD). 17594/ 2016 :

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to pay the petitioner s terminal benefits towards Leave Salary Rs.1,73,699/- along with 18% interest per annum within a stipulated time frame as may be fixed by this Court.

Prayer in WP(MD). 17595/ 2016 :

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to pay the petitioners terminal benefits towards gratuity amount of Rs.7,73,890/- Commutation Pension Rs.2,93,722/- leave salary Rs.4,22,282/- and other monetary benefits along with 18% interest per annum within a stipulated time frame as may be fixed by this court.

Prayer in WP(MD). 19384/ 2016 :

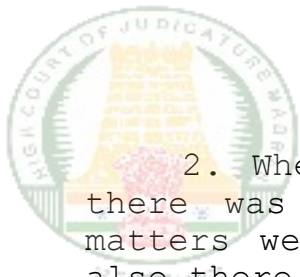
Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to pay the petitioner s terminal benefits towards gratuity amount Rs.6,65,913/- and leave salary Rs.1,74,265/- along with 18% interest per annum within a stipulated time frame as may be fixed by this Court.

He further submitted that this Court directed the respondents to settle the terminal benefits payable to the petitioners and the respondents have already paid the entire amount and complied with the orders of this Court.
