PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondent University to regularize the services of the petitioner as Clerk / Junior Assistant / Data Entry Operator in the respondent University with effect from the date of completion of 10 years of service as Consolidated Pay Casual Labourer (CPCLR) with effect from 14.11.2015 and sanction and release all attendant service benefits and monetary benefits to the petitioner.

Heard Mr.A.Rahul, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the writ petitioner and Mr.T.Sakthi Kumaran, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent.

2.The learned counsel appearing on behalf of the writ petitioner submitted that the writ petitioner was working as Clerk / Data Entry Operator for the past 15 years, but her service has not been regularized till date. Hence, she made representation 10.01.2017. But, so far, the same has not been considered.
