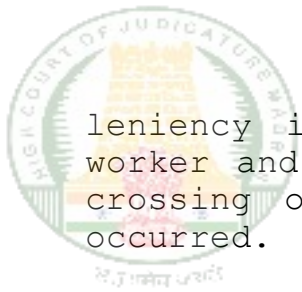
PRAYER: Petition filed under Section 397 r/w 401 of Criminal Procedure Code, to call for the records and set aside the Judgment passed in Criminal Appeal No.92 of 2010, dated 28.02.2011 on the file of the Additional District and Sessions Cum Fast Track Court, Pudukkottai confirming the judgment and modified the sentence passed in C.C.No.309 of 2007, dated 20.07.2010 on the file of the Judicial Magistrate, Pudukkottai and acquit the revision petitioner.

Government Advocate (CrI.side)**ORDER**

The petitioner was found guilty of the offence under Section 304(A) of IPC by the Courts below. The Courts below after appreciating the evidence on record have concurrently come to the conclusion that the petitioner by his negligent riding of the two wheeler caused the death of six year old child on 27.08.2007 at 8.35 in Sathirappatti-Moollur Road.

2.The petitioner's counsel submitted that he is not questioning the finding of guilt and that he is only pleading for



leniency in the matter of sentence. The petitioner is a coolie worker and he is having two children and that, but for the sudden crossing of the road by the child, the accident would not have occurred.

3. Taking into account these aspects, I am of the view that interest of justice will be served by reducing the period of imprisonment from six months simple imprisonment to three months simple imprisonment. With this modification in the matter of sentence, this criminal revision case is partly allowed.

4. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner would surrender before the trial Magistrate within a period of 20 days. The learned trial Magistrate will take steps to enforce this order.
