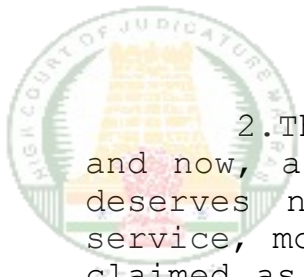

ORDER

The order of transfer dated 02.08.2011, transferring the
<https://www.e-courts.gov.in/home/> from Courtallam Police Station to Pappakudi Police
Station is under challenge in the present Writ Petition.



2.The impugned order of transfer was issued on 02.08.2011 and now, after a lapse of about 8 ½ years, the order of transfer deserves no merit consideration. Transfer is an incidental to service, more so a condition to service. Place or post can never be claimed as a matter of right. Administrative transfer ought to be issued by the competent authorities in the interest of public administration. This apart, the writ petitioner is serving in uniformed service and therefore, the transfers are inevitable and imminent.

3.Thus, this Court is of the considered opinion that the order of transfer issued on 02.08.2011 is in accordance with the transfer policy and there is no infirmity in the transfer order passed by the third respondent.

4.With these observations, this Writ Petition stands dismissed. No costs.
