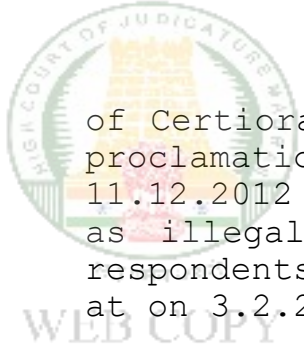

2.In view of the same, these Writ Petitions are dismissed as withdrawn. No costs. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petitions are dismissed.

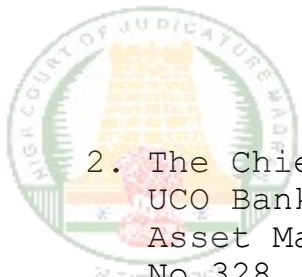
