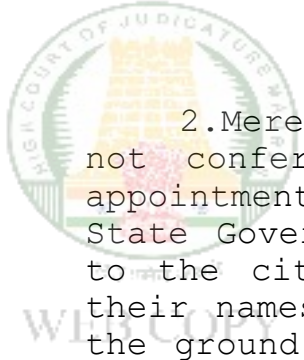

COMMON ORDER

The relief sought for in the present writ petitions are to direct the respondents to sponsor the name of the writ petitioner for interview for paramedical posts and further to direct the second and third respondents to consider the petitioners' name for appointment on regular basis as Hospital Servant / Paramedical Staff.



2. Mere registration of names in the Employment Exchange would not confer any right on the candidate to seek sponsorship or appointment. The facility of Employment Exchange is provided by the State Government to provide equal opportunity in public employment to the citizen at large. The candidates who all are registered their names in the Employment Exchange, cannot seek appointment on the ground that they are waiting for long years. Registration of names in the Employment Exchange is a facility provided. Such a facility would not confer any right on the candidate to seek appointment. The writ petitioners can question the appointment if at all the authority competent had violated the Rule of seniority or the other procedures contemplated.

3. In the event of not substantiating any such acceptable legal grounds, the relief as such sought for cannot be granted. However, the names of the writ petitioners can be considered for appointment, in accordance with their seniority and as per the Rules in force.

4. Accordingly, these writ petitions are dismissed. No costs.
