

HONOURABLE JUSTICE G. SRI DEVI

ORDER:

The petitioner, who is accused in Cr.No.527 of 2018 on the file of the Station House Officer, Kushaiguda Police Station, Pachakonda registered for the offences punishable under Sections 379, 406 and 420 IPC basing on the complaint of the 2nd respondent/ defacto-complainant, filed this Criminal Petition under Section 482 CrPC to quash the proceedings in the above crime.

2. Both the petitioner and the defacto-complainant along with their respective counsel present and the parties were identified by their respective counsel. When examined they stated that they intend to compromise the matter pending criminal petition and filed petitions seeking to permit them to compromise the matter and compound the offences alleged against the petitioner.

3. Perused the petitions vide I.A.Nos.2 and 3 of 2019 filed by the defacto-complainant for permission to compromise the matter with the petitioner and consequently quash the proceedings in the above case against the petitioner. Along with the petition in I.A.No.3 of 2019, a joint memo duly signed by both the parties along with their respective counsel is filed wherein they stated that they have amicably settled the disputes between them in pursuance to the closure letter dt.24.09.2018 addressed to the petitioner by M/s HPCL, and the defacto-complainant has no objection to quash the proceedings in the above case against the petitioner. The joint memo is also supported by the affidavit of the defacto-complainant.

4. Thus in view of the compromise between the parties settling the disputes amicably, they are permitted to compromise the matter and the offences alleged against the petitioner are compounded. The compromise is recorded.

5. Accordingly, I.A.Nos.2 and 3 of 2019 are allowed and the Criminal Petition is also allowed quashing the proceedings in Cr.No.527 of 2018 on the file of the Station House Officer, Kusaiguda Police Station, Pachakonda, against the petitioner. The bail bonds, if any, of the petitioner shall stand cancelled.

6. Miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
