COMMON ORDER :

When these matters are taken up for hearing, counsel for petitioners submitted that he has no instructions to argue these matters, and accordingly, these writ petitions may be closed, however, liberty may be given to the petitioners to pursue their legal remedies in accordance with law, if any cause survives.
