

**HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE ABHINAND KUMAR SHAVILI**

**WRIT PETITION No.14093 of 2005**

**ORDER:**

When the matter is taken up for hearing, learned counsel appearing for both parties submitted that in order to give quietus to this long pending litigation, this writ petition may be disposed of modifying the orders passed by the Labour Court in E.P.No.9 of 1996 in I.D.No.139 of 1994, dated 16.06.2005, to the extent of the amounts which are already deposited i.e., 50% of the amount adjudicated by the Labour Court in I.D.No.139 of 1994, which would ensure justice to both parties.

In view of the above submission, the writ petition is disposed of modifying the orders passed by the Labour Court in E.P.No.9 of 1996 in I.D.No.139 of 1994, dated 16.06.2005, to the extent of the amounts which are already deposited i.e., 50% of the amount awarded by the Labour Court in I.D.No.139 of 1994. The 1<sup>st</sup> respondent is entitled to withdraw the amount deposited, without furnishing any security, if not already withdrawn. No order as to costs.

Pending miscellaneous petitions, if any, shall stand closed.
