

THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE CHALLA KODANDA RAM

WRIT PETITION No.9260 of 2019

O R D E R:

This Writ Petition is filed for the following relief:

“...to issue appropriate Writ or any other order or direction particularly one in the nature of Writ of mandamus to declare the action of respondent No.3 in not renewing the fitness of the petitioners' vehicles, in spite of their repeated requests as arbitrary, illegal, unconstitutional and consequently direct respondent No.3 to renew the fitness of the petitioners' vehicles at the earliest”.

2. When the matter is taken up, it is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned Government Pleader for Transport appearing for the respondents that the issue raised in the present Writ Petition is squarely covered by the orders, dated 06.04.2017 and 06.02.2019, passed by this Court in W.P.Nos.9570 of 2017 and 2253 of 2019 respectively.

Relevant portion of the aforesaid orders read as under:

“In those circumstances, the Writ Petition is allowed directing the respondent authorities to allow the petitioners forthwith to submit their applications through online and process the same as expeditiously as possible and complete the testing formalities within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order. However, it is made clear that the respondent authorities may take action against the petitioners for furnishing the alleged fake addresses and getting their vehicles registered, in accordance with law.”

Following the aforesaid order and for the reasons stated therein, this Writ Petition is also allowed in terms thereof. There shall be no order as to costs.

3. Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in this Writ Petition shall stand disposed of.
