COMMON ORDER:

- 1) This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. to quash the proceedings in D.V.C.No.65 of 2017 on the file of the IV Metropolitan Magistrate at Hyderabad against the petitioners.
- 2) During pendency of the Criminal Petition, I.A.No.2 of 2019 came to be filed by the first respondent to compound the offences and to record the compromise. Along with the petition, a joint memo which is signed by the parties and their counsel came to be filed, *inter alia*, stating that at the intervention of elders and well wishers, the parties have settled their disputes in terms of the compromise. The said joint memo has been supported by the affidavit of the first respondent.
- 3) Today, both the parties are present before this Court and they were identified by their respective counsel. This Court, when examined, both the parties have stated that at the instance of the elders, they have settled the matter out of the Court and the first respondent has no objection for quashing the proceedings against the petitioners.
- 4) In the light of the compromise arrived at between the parties, the compromise memo filed by both the parties is recorded and I.A.No.2 of 2019 is ordered.

5) Consequently, the Criminal Petition is allowed in terms of compromise and the proceedings in D.V.C.No.65 of 2017 on the file of the IV Metropolitan Magistrate at Hyderabad, are hereby quashed against the petitioners/ A.1 to A.4.

6) Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending, shall stand closed.
