

HONOURABLE JUSTICE G. SRI DEVI  
CRIMINAL PETITION No. 3773 of 2019

ORDER:

1. This Criminal Petition, under Section 482 Cr.P.C., is filed by the petitioners/ A.7 and A.8, seeking to quash the proceedings in Crime No.559 of 2019 of Rajendranagar Police Station, Cyberabad, registered for the offences punishable under Section 498-A of IPC and Sections 3 and 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act.

2. Though the criminal petition is filed to quash the aforesaid proceedings, during the course of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioners/ A.7 and A.8 restricts his prayer seeking a direction to the Investigating agency to follow the procedure prescribed under Section 41-A Cr.P.C. and the guidelines prescribed by the Apex Court in *Arnesh Kumar v. State of Bihar and another*<sup>1</sup>.

3. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor fairly concedes the request of the learned counsel for the petitioners/ A.7 and A.8.

4. In that view of the matter, the Criminal Petition is disposed of directing the police concerned to follow the provisions under Section 41-A Cr.P.C. and abide by the directions of the Apex Court as set out in *Arnesh Kumar's case* (supra).

As a sequel thereto, miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending shall stand closed.
