ORDER:

The petitioners, who are accused Nos.1 to 3, in Crime No.49 of 2019 of Ameenpur Police Station, Sangareddy District, registered for the offence punishable under Section 306 I.P.C., filed this Criminal Petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. to quash the proceedings against them in the aforesaid crime.

2. During pendency of the Criminal Petition, I.A.Nos.3 and 4 of 2019 came to be filed by the second respondent-*de facto* complainant to record the compromise and to compound the offence. Along with the petitions, a joint memo came to be filed, *inter alia* stating that at the intervention of elders and well wishers, the parties have settled their disputes in terms of the compromise. The said joint memo has been supported by the affidavit of the second respondent.

3. Today, both the parties are present before this Court and they are identified by their respective counsel. This Court, when examined, both the parties have stated that at the instance of the elders, they have settled the matter out of the Court and the second respondent has no objection for quashing the proceedings against the petitioners.

4. In the light of the compromise arrived at between the parties, the compromise memo filed by both the parties is recorded and I.A.Nos.3 and 4 of 2019 are ordered subject to both parties

depositing costs of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees one thousand only) each in favour of High Court Legal Services Committee.

5. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is allowed in terms of compromise, and the proceedings in Crime No.49 of 2019 of Ameenpur Police Station, Sangareddy District, against the present petitioners-accused Nos.1 to 3 are hereby quashed.

Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending, shall stand closed.
