ORDER:

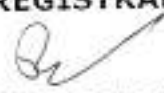
"This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking to relax the condition imposed by this Court in Crl.P. No. 5279 of 2019, vide order dated 12-09-2019 to the effect that the petitioner shall not leave the jurisdiction of the Court without prior permission.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent-State.

In view of the reasons stated in the affidavit, filed in support of the application, the application is allowed relaxing the aforesaid condition and the same is modified to the effect that the petitioner shall not leave the territory of India without prior permission."
