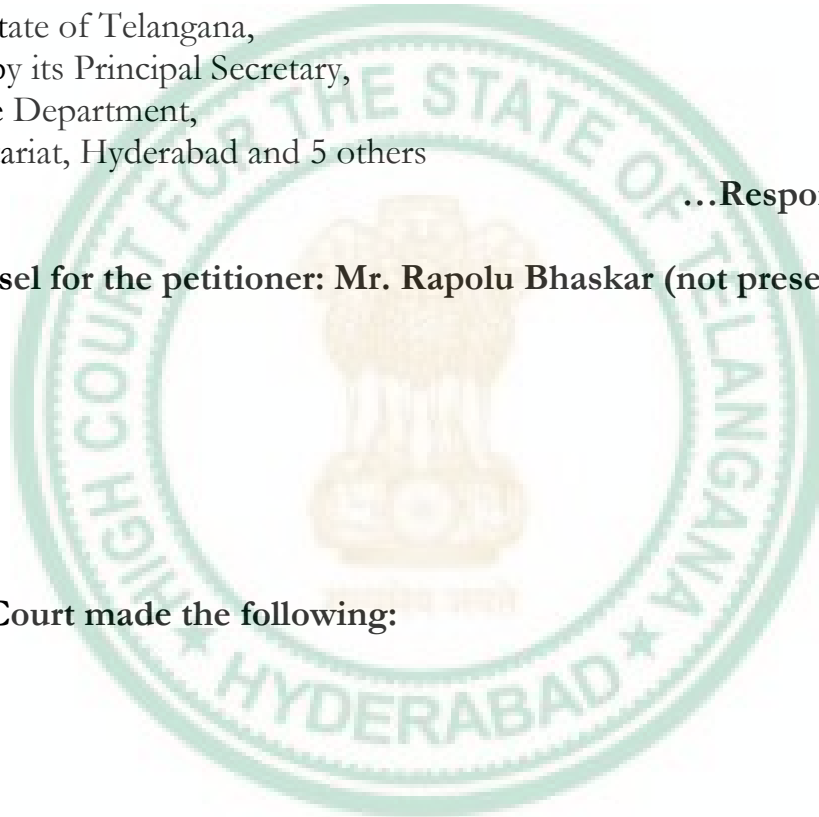

This Habeas Corpus petition is filed for a direction to the respondents to produce the petitioner's husband, *namely* Kunchala Raju, before this Court.

By order dated 19-09-2019, this Court had clearly directed that, in case the learned counsel for the petitioner does not appear before this Court on the next date, this case shall be dismissed for non-prosecution.
