ORDER:

1) The petitioners, who are accused Nos.1 to 6 in Crime No.166 of 2019 of Bhupalapally Police Station, filed this Criminal Petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. to quash the proceedings in the above crime, which was registered for the offences punishable under Sections 306 read with 34 IPC.

2) Along with the Criminal Petition, I.A.No.4 of 2019 came to be filed by the second respondent to record the compromise. Along with the petition, a joint memo which is signed by the parties and their counsel came to be filed, *inter alia* stating that at the intervention of elders and well wishers, the parties have settled their disputes in terms of the compromise. The said joint memo has been supported by the affidavit of the second respondent.

3) Today, both the parties are present before this Court and they were identified by their respective counsel. This Court, when examined, both the parties have stated that at the instance of the elders, they have settled the matter out of the Court and the second respondent has no objection for quashing the proceedings against the petitioners.

4. In the light of the compromise arrived at between the parties, the compromise memo filed by both the parties is recorded and I.A.No.4 of 2019 is ordered subject to the petitioners

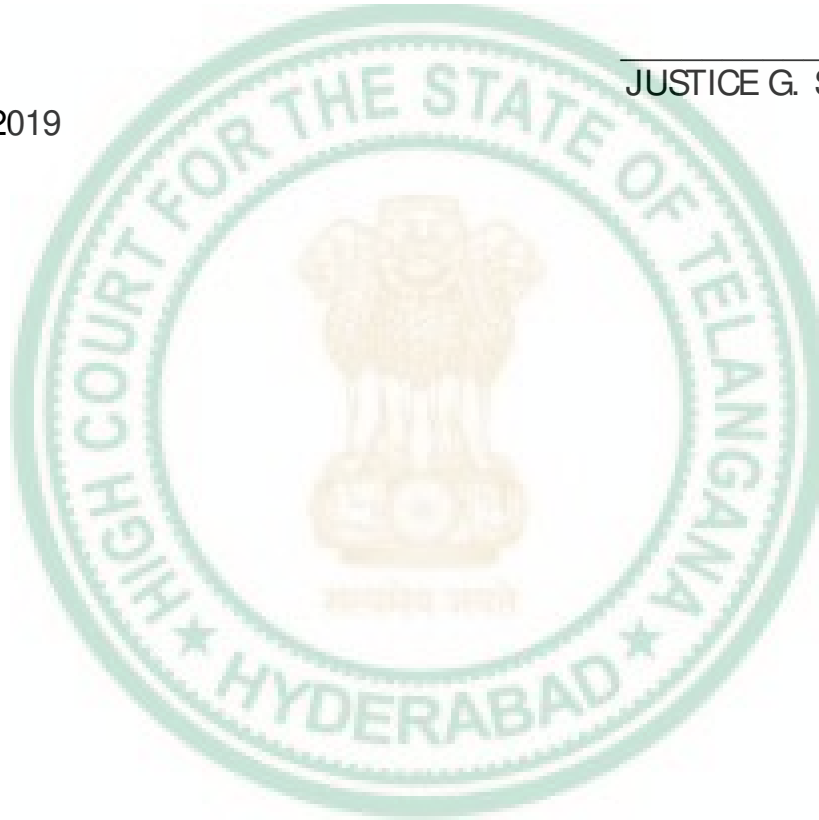
depositing costs of Rs.15,000/- (Rupees fifteen thousand only) in favour of High Court Legal Services Committee.

4) Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is allowed in terms of compromise and the proceedings in Crime No. 166 of 2019 of Bhupalapally Police Station, against the petitioners are hereby quashed.

5) Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending, shall stand closed.
