

HONOURABLE JUSTICE G. SRI DEVI

CRIMINAL PETITION NO.6993 OF 2019

ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking quashing of investigation in Crime No.356 of 2019 of P.S. Bhupalpally, Jayashankar Bhupalpally District, registered against the petitioners/A-1 and A-2 for the offences punishable under Section 3(1)(s) & 3(2)(va) of the SCs & STs (POA) Act and Sections 420 and 506 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Though the learned counsel for the petitioners/A-1 and A-2 filed the present petition for quashing of investigation in Crime No.356 of 2019, he restricts his prayer seeking a direction to the Investigating agency to follow the procedure prescribed under Section 41-A of the Code of Criminal Procedure and the guidelines prescribed by the Apex Court in ***Arnesh Kumar v. State of Bihar and another***¹.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that the directions of the Apex Court have to be followed and implemented.

In that view of the matter, the Criminal Petition is disposed of directing the police to abide by the directions of the Apex Court as set out in ***Arnesh Kumar case (supra)***. No coercive steps shall be taken against the petitioners/A-1 and A-2 till filing of the final report.
