

THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE CHALLA KODANDA RAM

WRIT PETITION No. 27709 of 2019

ORDER:

This Writ Petition is filed for the following relief:

“....to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, to declare the inaction of the respondent Nos. 1 to 3 herein in releasing the power supply to the premises constructed in Plot No. 75 LIG Category, situated at Bathakammakunta, Bagh Amberpet, Hyderabad in spite of completion of the formalities and payment of the requisite amount as being illegal, arbitrary and unjust and consequently direct respondent Nos. 1 to 3 herein to release the power supply without insisting to Occupancy Certificate from the 4th respondent”

When the matter is taken up, it is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the issue raised in the present Writ Petition is squarely covered by the order dated 25.09.2019 passed by this Court in W.P.No.21100 of 2019.

Sri R. Vinod Reddy, learned Standing Counsel for Telangana State Southern Power Distribution Company Limited appearing for respondent Nos.1 to 3 and Sri Sampath Prabhakar Reddy, learned Standing Counsel for Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation, appearing for respondent No.4, do not dispute the aforesaid submission.

In view of the above, for the reasons alike in the said order, this Writ Petition is disposed of directing the respondents to release individual service connection to the petitioner within a period of

four (4) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, and the same shall be subject to further direction that may be issued by the State of Telangana or the Apex Court in the litigation pending before it arising out of the order dated 12.09.2012 in Writ Petition No.20407 of 2008 and batch.

Miscellaneous Petitions, if any pending, shall stand disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.
