C.R.M No.2610 of 2019

For the reasons recorded, the application is allowed. The date of FIR No.310 in the petition is corrected to 24.06.2017 from 24.06.2018.

Registry is directed to make necessary corrections.

C.R.M-M No.13 of 2019

This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.310 dated 24.06.2018 registered under Sections 147, 149, 323, 506, 120-B IPC at P.S. Faridabad Kotwali.

Learned Deputy Advocate General states that the petitioner has been granted bail by the trial Court in view of the interim order and he has

no objection if the interim order is confirmed.

In the circumstances, keeping in view the entire conspectus of facts, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Petition is allowed. Interim order is made absolute.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
