Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that they had appeared in the examination for PGT History Category No.8 in which there were 398 posts. The result of the written examination was declared on 16.11.2018 and revised result was declared on 23.12.2018. Petitioners have qualified the said examination. However, suddenly, on 25.12.2018 an advertisement was inserted in the newspaper "The Tribune" that the interview is fixed for 26.12.2018 at 9.00 am with the advise that the admit card can be downloaded from the internet from the website of the Commission. Learned counsel further contends that the notice was too short for the petitioners to appear in the said interview and the result of the same is yet to be declared.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Surender Singh Pannu, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on

behalf of the State. Copy of the petition be supplied to State counsel during course of the day.

Prima facie this Court is of the view that the notice for interview is too short and there is every likelihood that some of the candidates may miss the interview on account of short notice. The interviews were to be held at Panchkula. Petitioners belong to Kaithal and Yamunanagar. Due to winter season, it is foggy in the evening and morning hours. The interview was fixed at 9.00 am. Since the result of the interview is yet to be declared, a direction is issued to the respondents to interview the petitioners immediately tomorrow i.e. 03.01.2019 at 10.00 am and consider the case of the petitioners also before declaring the result, if they fall in the consideration zone.

Disposed of accordingly.
