Mr. S.K. Garg Narwana, Senior Advocate, assisted by Mr.
Teevar Sharma, Advocate, appears of his own, on behalf of respondents.

The learned senior counsel for appellant, inter alia, contends that appellant has applied on 14.11.2018 for the post of Director, PGIMS, Rohtak. He has been suspended from service on 19.11.2018, vide order/letter dated 19.11.2018 (Annexure-P-2). He challenged said order/letter before Single Bench of this Court. The Single Bench of this Court, vide order dated 20.12.2018, passed in CWP-30969-2018, refused to stay suspension.

Undisputedly, chargesheet has been issued to appellant. We are of the view that it is not desirable to comment on the merits of controversy. One of grievances of appellant is that suspension order dated 19.11.2018 (Annexure-P-2) has been passed to frustrate his application for the post of Director, PGIMS, Rohtak. The Single Bench of this Court has already refused to grant stay of suspension and fixed the case for 26.2.2019. In order to ensure that civil writ petition is decided expeditiously, we direct

that case be put up before Single Bench on 8.1.2019. As reply in this case has already been filed, therefore, we request the Single Bench to decide the civil writ petition expeditiously, preferably within thirty days.
