JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)

1. This is a petition that has been filed under Section 11(6) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (for short 'the Act') for the appointment of an Arbitrator to adjudicate the disputes and differences arising out of the partnership deed executed between the parties.

2. Counsel for the respondent does not dispute the existence of the partnership deed containing arbitration clause 22.

3. In view of the above, an independent Arbitrator is to be appointed to resolve the disputes between the parties.

4. Accordingly, I hereby appoint Mr. R.S. Baswana, a retired District & Sessions Judge from Haryana, resident of H.No.437, Sector 21-C,

Faridabad (M.No.9466594777) to function as a sole Arbitrator to settle the disputes and differences between the parties. The fee etc. shall be paid as per the Chandigarh Arbitration Centre (CAC) Rules, 2018 and the venue of the arbitration will be at Faridabad.

5. The petition stands allowed accordingly.
