AVNEESH JHINGAN, J. (Oral)

The present contempt petition is filed under Sections 10 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 alleging violation of interim order passed in CWP No. 5554 of 1994. While issuing notice of motion, operation of the scheme (Annexure P-12 in the writ petition) was stayed. The said order was modified and it was ordered that the respondents were in possession of some land and were raising constructions and would continue the construction subject of the outcome of the writ petition.

Learned State counsel submits that the main petition was dismissed on 05.02.1997.

From the perusal of the judgment, it is forthcoming that the Court observed that the petitioners have not set up the case that they are entitled to a site under the Land Disposal Rules. It was further directed that in case, they are entitled under the Rules, they may approach the authorities for allotment of site.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is not in a position to contradict the said factual position.

In view of the fact that the main writ petition is dismissed, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition.

The contempt petition is dismissed.
