Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.133 dated 30.10.2018 registered under Sections 324 IPC and 326 IPC (added later on) at Police Station Subhanpur, District Kapurthala.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that this is a cross-version case as there was a fight between the parties. Earlier the petitioner was released on bail as necessary recoveries were made but later on Section 326 IPC was added.

Learned Senior Deputy Advocate General on instructions from H.C. Jaswinder Singh, P.S. Subhanpur has accepted that necessary recoveries were made and that the petitioner had not misused the concession of bail.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Resultantly, the petition is allowed. In the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on bail by the Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petitioner is directed to appear before the investigating officer on any other date as and when his presence is required. In case the petitioner does not appear before the investigating officer in the aforesaid manner the present petition would be deemed to have been dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
