Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'Cr.P.C') for grant of pre arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.165 dated 28.10.2018, under Sections 323/34 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC') (Section 307 IPC added lateron) registered at Police Station Ding, District Sirsa.

While issuing notice of motion, this court passed the following order on 08.01.2019:-

*“Contends that in the same very occurrence, the petitioner had also suffered injuries and a reference is made to the MLR Annexure P-1 and thus, it is yet to be ascertained during trial as to who was the aggressor party?*

*Notice of motion for 11.02.2019.*

*In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his*

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*satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.*

*Mr. Angel Sharma, Advocate appears on behalf of complainant and files vakalatnama, same is taken on record.”*

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from SI Dilbagh Singh has acknowledged that in terms of the previous order the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required in this case.

In view of above, the interim order dated 08.01.2019 is made absolute, subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.
