ARB-22-2018

1. This is a petition that has been filed under Section 11(6) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (for short 'the Act') for the appointment of an Arbitrator to adjudicate the disputes and differences arising out of the contract/agreement executed between the parties.
2. A perusal of the paper book would reveal that a contract agreement dated 26.11.2013 was executed between the parties for doing the work namely *P/L CC flooring and cables in Ward No.25, Kesri Bagh,*

Amritsar. On account of a dispute that has arisen, the matter is sought to be referred to an Arbitrator in terms of clause 25(5) of the contract agreement.

3. Counsel for the respondents does not dispute the existence of the arbitration clause.

4. In view of the above, an independent Arbitrator is to be appointed to resolve the disputes between the parties.

5. Accordingly, I hereby appoint Sh. Jagroop Singh, a retired District and Sessions Judge, to function as a sole Arbitrator to settle the disputes and differences between the parties. The fee etc. shall be paid as per the Chandigarh Arbitration Centre (CAC) Rules, 2018.

6. The petition stands allowed accordingly.
