The present petition had been filed under Section 11(6) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (for short – the Act) for appointment of an Arbitrator in a domestic commercial dispute.

The petitioner and the respondents entered into an agreement for providing Sewerage Scheme in Ambala City. Admittedly, as per clause 25 A of the agreement disputes between the parties were to be settled through Arbitration.

On disputes having arisen between the parties, in terms of the afore-referred clause 25A of the agreement between them, the petitioner issued a legal notice to the respondents for appointment of an Arbitrator.

The respondents did not respond to the legal notice occasioning the filing of the present petition.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, to adjudicate upon the disputes between them, Justice Inderjeet Singh (Retd.) is appointed as the sole Arbitrator. However, such appointment would be subject to the declaration to be made by Justice Inderjeet Singh (Retd.) under Section 12 of the Act with regard to his independence and impartiality to settle the dispute between the parties.

The Arbitrator is requested to complete the proceedings within the time limit specified under Section 29A of the Act.

The Arbitrator shall be paid fee in accordance with the Fourth Schedule of the Act, as amended.

As per agreement expressed by learned counsel for the parties for the sake of the convenience of their respective clients as also of the Arbitrator, the venue of the Arbitration shall be at New Chandigarh, where Justice Inderjeet Singh (Retd.) resides.

After seeking the convenience of the Arbitrator, the parties are directed to appear before the Arbitrator on 13.12.2019 at 11.00 A.M. or any other date suitable to all concerned.

The matter is disposed of in the above terms.
