On the request made by learned counsel for the applicant, the application for withdrawal of the petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.

ARB-284-2018

This is an application under Section 11(6) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 for appointment of an arbitrator to settle the disputes and differences between the parties arising out of the contract.

2. The contract undisputedly contains an arbitration clause. There is also a dispute between the parties inasmuch as both of them have named their arbitrator at different stages, but the arbitrator nominated by one is not acceptable to the other. However, learned counsel for both the parties have consented before me that this Court may appoint an independent arbitrator.

In these circumstances, I hereby appoint Mr. Balbir Singh, retired District & Sessions Judge, Haryana, (115-SP, Sector 25, Panchkula, 94167-91008, 0172-2550107) to act as an arbitrator to settle the disputes and differences between the parties. The fees shall be as per the Chandigarh Arbitration Centre (CAC) Rules, 2018.
4. The application accordingly stands disposed of.
