This is an application under Section 11 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 for the appointment of an arbitrator.

2. Reply filed on behalf of the respondents in Court today is taken on record.

3. Learned counsel for the parties agree for appointment of an arbitrator. However, learned counsel for the respondents states that an issue concerning limitation is also involved. The same may also be raised before the arbitrator and shall be adjudicated upon.

In view of the above, the application is disposed of by appointing Mr. O.P.Gupta, District & Sessions Judge (Retd.), # 901, Sector 8, Panchkula, Haryana, as an arbitrator to adjudicate upon the disputes and differences between the parties. The fees shall be as per the Chandigarh Arbitration Centre (CAC) (Administrative Cost and Arbitrators' Fees) Rules, 2014 or as may be settled by the parties and the arbitrator.
