Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Sukhdev Singh, Police Station Makhu District Ferozepur submits that the petitioner is no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and that he has no objection if the petitioner is granted the anticipatory bail.

In the light of the statement made by the learned State counsel, the interim relief granted to the petitioner vide order dated 13.02.2019 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438(2)
