Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 to 12.

Counsel for respondents No.4 and 5 – parents of the petitioner No.1 states that respondent No.5 may be allowed to meet petitioner No.1.

Request has been accepted and respondent No.5 was allowed to meet the daughter-petitioner No.1 in the Chamber of this Court. Even thereafter the daughter-petitioner No.1 is adamant that she wants to live with the boy-petitioner No.2.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. In support of her proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of the Aadhar Card (Annexure P-1) wherein her date of birth is mentioned as 24.08.1998 whereas petitioner No.2 has also placed on record a copy of Adhaar Card (Annexure P-2) depicting his year of birth as 1998. They have also moved a representation before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot (Annexure P-5) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-5).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
