The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.365 dated 17.04.2018 registered under Sections147/149/302 IPC and Section 3 of Scheduled Caste & Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act at Police Station Sadar Hissar.

Vide order dated 22.01.2019, the present petition was restricted only qua the limited relief of interim bail for one month for the reason that the wife of the petitioner has given birth to a child on 10.01.2019. The State was directed to verify the fact regarding the wife of the petitioner giving birth to a child.

Mr. Satyawar, SI has appeared and informed that the factum of the wife of the petitioner giving birth to a child is correct. The Officer has placed on record the report qua the health of the child as well, which suggests that the newly born has got some problem. Otherwise also, having become father, it would not be justified if the petitioner is not granted concession of interim bail for some time.

In view of the above, the petitioner is granted interim bail for a period of three weeks from the date of his actual release on interim bail. Let the petitioner be released on interim bail on his furnishing bonds/ sureties to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate.

Needless to say that after availing the interim bail, the petitioner shall surrender before the concerned Court/ Jail Authorities on the last day when the period of three weeks from his actual release expires.
