Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem*, that the present contempt petition arises from an interim order passed by the District Judge, SAS Nagar Mohali under Section 9 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and the main arbitration has been decided against the petitioner. It is also not disputed that the objections against the rejection of the claim by the Arbitrator is pending.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the contempt petition, at this stage, with liberty to file fresh, if cause of action still survives after the decision on the objections.
