By way of filing this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 for conducting a fair and impartial inquiry in his representation dated 5.12.2018 (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel has submitted that the private respondents are a gang of cheats and defraud innocent persons and in fact had defrauded the petitioner to the tune of ₹40 lacs by representing that they would send husband of the petitioner abroad. Learned counsel has further submitted that in fact another FIR also stands lodged against the said private respondents wherein they had duped another person identically.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali, Punjab (respondent No.2) to look into the matter and to

dispose of representation dated 5.12.2018 (Annexure P-1) expeditiously. In case the allegations leveled therein are found to be well founded then necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon in accordance with law at the earliest.

A copy of this order along with copy of representation Annexure P-1 be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali, Punjab (respondent No.2) so as to enable him to do the needful.
