The grievance raised in the present contempt petition is that in spite of status quo order by this Court on 28.6.2017 with respect to the services of the petitioners, yet their services have been terminated.

Learned counsel for the petitioners fairly submits that with regard to petitioner No. 2, there is no controversy as she is not having due registration as required.

On the last date of hearing, learned counsel for the respondents placed reliance upon Annexure R-3 whereby services of the petitioners were terminated. He was not able to defend the said order.

Today, on instructions from Mr. Dilbag Singh, Officer-in-

Charge, ECHS Polyclinic, Gurdaspur, learned counsel for the respondents

submits that henceforth the respondents will withdraw the said order and seeks liberty to proceed in accordance with law.

In view of the fact that there is no grievance raised by petitioner No. 2 with regard to termination of the services, the contempt petition is disposed of in view of the statement made today in Court. However, the respondents shall be at liberty to proceed in accordance with law with respect to petitioner No. 1.
