The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 9.11.2017, vide which direction was issued to decide the legal notice dated 21.9.2017 in the light of the judgment rendered in CWP No.22404 of 2017, titled as Joginder Singh vs. Punjab State Power Corporation Limited and others, decided on 29.9.2017.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that speaking order has been passed. In pursuance to the said order, revised pension payment order and revised gratuity order have been passed and the amount has been released to the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.

However, learned counsel for the respondent shall hand over the copy of the aforesaid speaking order to learned counsel for the petitioner

within two days. In case, the petitioner is still aggrieved in any manner by the passing the said order or in case of any discrepancy in the amount paid, he is at liberty to avail remedy available to him in accordance with law.

It is stated that there is nothing on record to show that the interest has been paid to the petitioner or any order has been passed qua interest part. If it is so, the respondent is directed to take a decision for interest part and if the petitioner is found to be entitled for the same, that too be disbursed to the petitioner within two months from today.
