The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 30.11.2016 passed by this Court in CWP No. 13563 of 2016 and other connected matters. The operational part of the order is reproduced below:-

“Therefore, CM No.15228-CWP of 2016 is allowed and in continuation/modification of the order dated 10.08.2016, it is ordered that the petitioners, as also other similarly situated employees (Masters/Mistresses) shall be granted provisional promotions to the post of Lecturer in their respective streams as per their seniority subject to fulfillment of the promotional criteria, against the available vacancies in the promotion quota subject to the final outcome of the present set of writ petitions. Thus, the State is discharged from its stated stand in the order dated 10.08.2016 regarding non-filling of the remaining vacancies in the promotion quota.”

Learned State counsel has placed on record the order dated 03.07.2019 passed by Director Public Instruction (SE), Punjab whereby, the claim of the petitioner was rejected holding that she did not fulfil the criteria for promotion.

In view of the above, the direction of this Court has been complied with, no further order is required to be passed in contempt petition.

Disposed of as infructuous. The rule issued against the respondents is hereby discharged.

However, it is clarified that if any grievance survives with regard to the order dated 03.07.2019, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies as are available in accordance with law.
