Learned counsel for the petitioner states that neither the respondents have allowed the petitioner to mark his presence after 14.8.2018 nor paid him salary from March, 2018 onwards.

Written statement has been filed. Today, learned State counsel has handed over a cheque in the name of petitioner for the salary from March, 2018 till 14.8.2018. It is further stated that vide order dated 8.8.2018, which is placed as Annexure R-2, the petitioner was directed to be deployed as Driver of the jeep/truck on DC rate but till date he has not joined.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that the petitioner was always ready to join. He was wrongly kept away from joining.

The petitioner is accordingly directed to report in the office of the respondents on 24.5.2019. In case, the petitioner comes to the office of the respondents on the said date, he will be allowed to perform his duty as

per the statement made before this Court.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
