The directions of this Court passed in CWP No. 25810 of 2018 on 17.12.2014 is that to consider the writ petition as representation along with complaint filed by the petitioner and pass an appropriate order thereon.

Pursuant to notice of motion, reply has been filed wherein it has been submitted that considering the representation and the complaint of the petitioners, certain encroachments found and appropriate proceedings have been initiated against the encroachers.
