AVNEESH JHINGAN, J. (Oral)

The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 28.03.2017 passed by the Educational Tribunal, Punjab. The operative part of the order is reproduced below:

“We are, therefore constrained to record that the management has with impunity violated principles of natural justice and trampled upon the rights of the petitioner. We, however, desist from recording any opinion on merits, but have no hesitation in accepting the petitioner's plea that the impugned order and proceedings are vitiated for violation of principles of natural justice. The petition is, therefore, allowed, the impugned order as well as the alleged inquiry report are set aside. The college is granted liberty to re-examine the entire matter and in case anything is found against the petitioner, to hold a detailed inquiry by adhering to the principles of natural justice and the rules applicable to aided posts.

Needless to add that with the setting aside of the impugned order, the petitioner shall be entitled to all consequential benefits, following therefrom. ”

Learned counsel for the respondents has produced a communication dated 09.09.2019 whereby four increments of the petitioner have been released. He further states that monetary benefits have also been credited to the account of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that liberty be granted to avail remedies in accordance with law, in case some grievance still survives.

Disposed of with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondents is discharged.
