The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of order dated 16.12.2016, vide which a direction was issued to the respondents to decide the legal notice/representation of the petitioner, keeping in view the inquiry report (Annexure P-8), was placed on record alongwith the writ petition.

Reply by way of affidavit of Keshni Anand Arora, Additional Chief Secretary and Financial Commissioner to Government Haryana on behalf of respondent No.1 and another reply by way of affidavit of Prabhjot Singh, IAS, the then Deputy Commissioner, Ambala now Deputy Commissioner, Sirsa on behalf of respondent No.2 are already on record.

As per para 2 of the reply filed by respondent No.1, the report as well as the representation filed by the petitioner were taken into consideration and accordingly, Devender Kumar, the then Patwari and Satish Kumar Goel, Naib Tehsildar were found guilty and accordingly 5% cut in the pension of Devender Kumar, the then Patwari for a period of 5

Goel, Naib Tehsildar has been forwarded to the Commissioner Ambala Division, Ambala. Even the fresh allegations against two Registry Clerks and a deed writer, they have been charge-sheeted and licence of the Deed Writer has been suspended. Reply filed by respondent No.2 which is more elaborate is also to the same effect.

In view of the same, there is no reason to continue with the present contempt petition.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
