The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to petitioner-Sukhbir Singh in case FIR No.105 dated 14.09.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 326-A, 326-B and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short, "IPC") at Police Station Ramdas, Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar.

The allegation in the FIR against co-accused Inderjit Singh @ Sonu and Jobanjit Singh @ Joban, is for throwing acid on the face of the prosecutrix. However, in the disclosure statement they have disclosed that they arranged this acid from the petitioner, who is running a milk dairy.

Petitioner is in custody since 15.09.2018. Final police report has been submitted. It will take some time to conclude the trial.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars, therefore, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular

bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the court.
