Learned counsel for the petitioner do not dispute that the possession has since been handed over and the mesne profit has been deposited up till 31.03.2018 but however contends that heavy penalty be imposed on the respondents for forcing the petitioner to come this Court to file contempt petition.

This Court deems it proper not to proceed with the present contempt petition any further in view of the possession having been handed over. Accordingly, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

In case the petitioner is aggrieved with not depositing the entire amount of mesne profit, she is at liberty to file the execution petition.
