AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

A writ petition bearing CWP No.3172 of 2017 was disposed of on 20.02.2017 giving liberty to the petitioners to approach the Joint Secretary/Special Secretary, Rehabilitation and Disaster Management, Haryana for recalling order dated 04.07.2016 by showing Annexures P-6 and P-7 (in the writ petition).

Pursuant to the directions of this Court, petitioners approached the respondent and order dated 06.09.2018 was passed by the Additional Secretary, Revenue-cum-Chief Settlement Commissioner, Haryana.

Today affidavit dated 23.09.2019 has been filed in the

Court annexing various documents including *roznamcha* of handing over physical possession of the property, same is taken on record. Copy is supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of reply filed, learned counsel for the petitioners states that no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition. However, he raises grievance that proprietary rights have not been granted by the Tehsildar.

However, respondents are directed that if there are no legal impediments or pending litigation with regard to said property, respondents shall ensure that needful would be done as expeditiously as possible.

The contempt petition is disposed of.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
