This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 16.1.2018 passed in CRM-M-1636 of 2018 whereby Senior Superintendent of Police Tarn Taran was directed to protect life and liberty of the petitioners by providing adequate protection after assessing the threat assessment.

Pursuant to notice of motion, reply dated 7.3.2019 was filed. Alongwith reply, an order dated 1.3.2018 has been annexed.

Learned State counsel submits that statement of father of the girl was recorded and thereafter it was ordered that as and when the husband and wife will appear before the local police, adequate protection will be provided. Copy of the order has also been sent to Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Goindwal Sahib and Station House Officer, Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran and they have been directed to provide security to the petitioners if approached.

In view of reply filed, learned counsel for the petitioners states that no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition, however, he seeks liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law, if need so arise.

Disposed of with liberty as prayed for.
