By way of filing this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the respondents so as to conduct fair investigation in the complaint Annexure P-1 made by her.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had purchased '*taud*' measuring 2 Marlas 6 Sarsahi situated in Village Gidderpindi, Hadbast No.209, Tehsil Shahkot and that while she was away from the village, respondent No.4 Sarabjit Singh, Panchayat Secretary, D.D.P.O. Jalandhar, District Jalandhar, while misusing his official position, had forcibly trespassed into her property and had destroyed the vegetable crops standing therein and had thus forcibly dispossessed her. It has further been submitted that although a complaint had been made to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Jalandhar but no action has been taken thereupon.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Jalandhar to look into the matter and to dispose of the

representation dated 5.12.2018 (Annexure P-1), moved by petitioner expeditiously in accordance with law. In case the allegations contained therein are found to be well founded then necessary steps be taken thereupon as warranted under law.

A copy of this order alongwith representation dated 5.12.2018 (Annexure P-1) be sent to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Jalandhar so as to enable him to do the needful.
