The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 30.09.2015.

While issuing notice of motion, it was specifically noticed that the revised appointment letters granting deemed dates of appointment w.e.f. 12.04.1990 along with the benefits of seniority and notional fixation of pay have not been extended.

Reply on behalf of respondent No.2 is already on record. As per the said reply, the order stands complied. It is further evident from Annexure R-1 that the petitioner has been granted the benefits of appointment from deemed dated i.e. 12.04.1990, seniority and fixation of pay from the date his junior in rank were appointed. He has been entitled for pay fixation notionally from 12.04.1990 and actually from the date he joined his duty.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

In case the petitioner is aggrieved in any manner, he is at liberty to revive the contempt petition.
